



2020-2021 School Guidelines (Covid Model)

Dear Families,

NANA'S utmost importance is the safety and well being of its students and employees. Therefore, NANA'S has created new regulations and set up schoolwide guidelines in efforts to prevent the spread of Covid-19 and maintain everyone's health.

NANA'S Fall Regulations and Guidelines:

- Teachers and staff members are required to stay home if sick and bring a clearance letter from their Dr. in order to return to school.
- Students showing any **sick symptoms** will be required to stay home and only return with a clearance letter from their pediatrician stating the child does not have Covid-19. Furthermore, students must be clear of any symptoms for over 24 hours.
- **DROP OFF & PICK UP:** All families are required to line up adjacent to the school building, and 6 feet apart from each other. ***please note Plaza common areas for pick up are not allowed to be used for playtime while social distancing regulations are in place.*
- All parents dropping and picking up their child must **properly** be wearing a mask.
- **TEMPERATURE CHECKS:** All teachers, staff and students will be required to have their temperature checked at the point of entry into the school. Any student with a temperature of 100.1 or higher will not be allowed into the school that day or the next. Parent/Guardian will be required to bring a Dr.'s note clearing the child to return to school.
- **CLEANING & DISINFECTING:** Maintenance personnel is present during the school day to keep restrooms, door handles, indoor and outdoor playground equipment clean and disinfected.
- **HANDWASHING:** All teachers, staff and students are required to wash their hands with soap and water throughout the day. Furthermore, alcohol gel solution is available throughout the school for teachers to provide and use.
